



2020 TABLOID SPORTS CARNIVAL PARENT INFORMATION

This year our school sports carnival will look a little different due to Covid-19 Stage 4 restrictions. It will still have a tabloid format which allows children to be actively involved in more events than traditional carnivals. This year students will start and finish the day in their classroom for roll call. The children will move around the oval in year level groups and take part in team games and individual events, **however, parents and spectators will be asked to remain in roped off viewing areas on the western, northern and eastern sides of the oval. Parents will not be able to approach the relay games or the House tents this year.**

Toilets	Public Toilets available
Time	8.50am All children will assemble on the top oval with bags, recess, drinks, hats, sunscreen. Children must wear runners and socks all day. Once assembled children move with class teachers to their House bays on the lower oval. 9.20am sharp – Block 1 commences. Pre Primary return to school at 10.30am, Year 1 & 2 return to school at 12.05pm.
Officials	There will <u>not</u> be parent helpers this year.
Team Bays	Children will return to team bays for recess, lunch and afternoon events.
Recess & Lunch Break	Children must provide their own recess. The Canteen will be offering a pre ordered sausage sizzle lunch to the students and parents will be able to purchase sausage sizzles down on the oval. A coffee van will be available on Santiago Park for spectators. Students will not be able to sit with their parents during the recess or lunch break.
Team colours	Children should wear their House shirt on the day. NO RUNNING SPIKES ALLOWED.
House Captains	Captains will assist by setting up equipment on the day of the carnival at 8.00am.
Athletic Medals	These will be awarded at the end of the carnival with the winning team shield. Medallions will be awarded in each grade level from Years 3 – 6. Boys Year 3, Girls Year 3 Boys Year 4, Girls Year 4 Boys Year 5, Girls Year 5 Boys Year 6, Girls Year 6 Please note: Awarding of medals will be based on performances in Long Jump, Shot Put, 400m (these events are conducted in PE classes in Term 3) and the 100m sprint on carnival day.
Weather	There is no back up day for this carnival this year. Poor weather will not deter us!
End of the day	All students are to remain at the carnival until it is completed to support their House. At the end of presentations all students will return to their class teacher on the oval and then return up to school to be dismissed as usual.
